The CHANCEN Income Share Agreement (ISA) covers your training costs during your training period, and once you graduate, you will be expected to pay back once you start earning an income. (Study now-Pay later scheme)

The following are criterias for selecting the admissible candidates:

- 1. Being a Rwandan
- 2. Being female is an advantage
- Having an Advanced Certificate of Education with ICT, Networking, Economics, Mathematics & Physics combinations or Bachelor's degree in ICT, Economics, Statistics and Management and other related fields for those who want to upgrade the skills in INES TVET school
- 4. Having the Accounting or Finance background and being an INES student and/or Alumni is an added advantage for those who want to upgrade their skills in CPA. New INES Students should have at least 50/60 marks in Secondary School, INES Alumni and continuing students should have at least Upper Second Class Honor
- Having Advanced diploma in French English or Languages with Education for those who want to upgrade the degree in French English with Education

The application file must comprise:

- 1. The certificate of secondary School and Bachelor's degree in TVET School
- 2. Transcripts or any other proof which shows Accounting or Finance background in CPA
- 3. Advanced diploma in French English with Education;
- 4. National ID
- 5. One Coloured passport photo

The students who are interested and need CHANCEN International Rwanda's financial support should apply online at_www.ines.ac.rw_and upload the application documents. The deadline is 20th March 2023 by 5PM.

N.B: Those who will be guaranteed CHANCEN's financial support will be communicated by INES-Ruhengeri and will start the class with the March intake. They will be required to attend a CHANCEN Workshop with their guardians before the date of starting classes.
